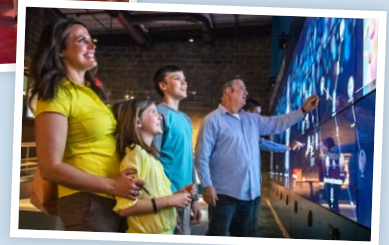

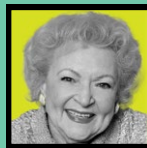

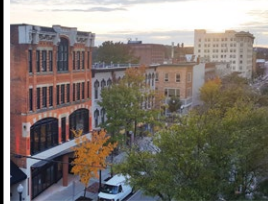


Chautauqua Belle

Downtown Jamestown



With the feel of a classic American downtown, Jamestown is noted for its rich history, striking architecture, sloping brick streets, beautiful open spaces, distinctive alleyways and scenic riverwalk. Explore wonderful local restaurants, retail shops, attractions and art galleries, along with outdoor murals celebrating hometown legend Lucille Ball.

This historic, 61-foot stone lighthouse and attached keeper's house was built in 1876. Guided tours include a climb up the 55-step spiral staircase to the upper observation level for a beautiful view of Lake Erie and the surrounding area, as well the many Lake Erie nautical artifacts and U.S. veterans displays in the museum.
